VOTER REGISTRATION in HENRICO COUNTY

The Henrico County Voter Registration and Elections Office requirements, locations, and times for the year 2008 are as follows:

Requirements of a registered voter in Virginia:

- A citizen of the United States
- 18 years of age by the next general election
- A resident of the precinct in which you vote
- If you have ever been convicted of a felony, you must have had your voting rights restored.
- If you have been declared mentally incapacitated in a Circuit Court and your civil rights have been removed, your capacity must have been restored.
