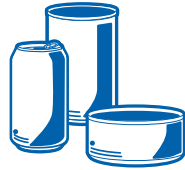


Accepted Items:

ALUMINUM CANS and FOIL and STEEL CANS

Aluminum and bi-metal beverage cans, "tin" or steel food cans, and aluminum foil or foil products.



NARROW NECK PLASTIC BOTTLES with a 1 or 2

Plastic soda bottles, milk and juice jugs, shampoo and detergent bottles



GLASS BOTTLES and JARS

Clear, green, light blue, and brown bottles or jars from food or beverages.



NEWSPAPER

Newspapers and glossy inserts that come with the paper.



CARDBOARD

Packing boxes, cereal and dry food boxes. Flatten all boxes.



MAIL, CATALOGS and MAGAZINES

OFFICE and COPY PAPER

TELEPHONE BOOKS



Do Not Include These Items:

Plastic bags of any kind



Styrofoam items



Plastic food trays/containers



Plastic tubs or cups (sour cream, butter, yogurt)



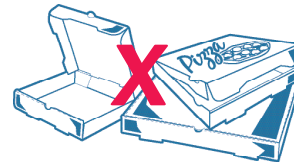
Milk cartons or juice boxes



Plastic or metal lids or caps



Food contaminated items (such as pizza boxes or foil)



Preparation Tips

- Rinse bottles, cans and jars.
- Throw away caps and lids.
- Remove and throw away liner bags from cereal and other dry food boxes.
- Flatten boxes to reduce size. Cardboard must be folded or cut to 2' x 3' or smaller. Place in, under or beside your bin.
- All recyclables can be mixed in the bin; there is **NO NEED TO SORT**.
- Need more space? Use paper bags or your own containers to hold extra items. **Do not use plastic bags.** Extra containers must be no larger than 40 gallons in size. Call CVWMA for stickers to label your extra containers.
- Do not cover recycling containers when you place them at the curb, even when it is raining.
- Put heavier items on top of light items to help prevent them from blowing out of your bin on windy days.
- Your recycling bin must be at the curb or street no later than 7:00 a.m. Curbside recyclables can be collected until 7:00 p.m.
- Place your bin in an open area at the curb or street away from driveways, cars, mailboxes or other obstructions.

Recycling Tips & Information

- Call the **Recycling Hotline** at **(804) 340-0900** to determine if your address is eligible for curbside recycling collection.
- The annual Curbside Recycling Collection Schedule is mailed to all eligible homes in January. The schedule illustrates when collection occurs.
- Plastic bags are not accepted and cannot be used to hold extra recyclables.
- Wheel kits are available for your bin at a nominal cost.
- When you move, leave the CVWMA recycling bin at your old house for the next resident; the bin is the property of your local government. Call CVWMA for information about recycling at your new house.

Holiday Collection Schedule

Curbside recycling is *not* collected on the following holidays:

- New Year's Day
- Memorial Day
- Independence Day
- Labor Day
- Thanksgiving Day
- Christmas Day

When curbside collection is scheduled **ON** one of these holidays or during the **SAME** week **AFTER** one of these holidays, collection will occur one day later.

Other holidays that your local government may observe do not affect curbside recycling collection.
